The Georgia State University Saturday School for Scholars and Leaders is proud to present a CSI Summer Camp for students in grades K-8.

- ✚ During camp, students will submerge themselves into the world of forensic science as they learn how to investigate crime scenes and solve complex mysteries. The STEM-based curriculum encourages students to make detailed observations, analyze key evidence, and strengthen their critical thinking skills through problem based learning scenarios.
- ✚ Four different class levels have been developed to ensure that each student is appropriately challenged through discovery and hands-on experience. Each class level has a special case to solve. Students will work together during C.S.I. camp to collect evidence in their evidence notebook against the criminal in their case. At the end of camp, students will determine the individual who is guilty of the crime and present their evidence to a judge.
